The Fourth Amendment to the United States Constitution limits the power of police to make arrests, search people and their property, and seize objects and contraband (such as illegal drugs or weapons). If you believe that your rights have been violated during a search and seizure, don't hesitate to contact a defense attorney to discuss your rights.

The skills of your attorney will be very influential in convincing the courts of a rights violation and subsequence suppression of evidence, so if you have reason to believe that illegal search and seizure took place in your drug case you should immediately speak with a lawyer at our firm so they can begin investigating this matter.
